RULES AND REGULATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

The Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology (CTLT) Student Photo Competition is open to all current undergraduate and graduate students at any UBC campus.

HOST

The Photo Conmpetition is hosted by the UBC Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology, 214 - 1961 East Mall, Vancouver, BC V6T 1Z1.

ENTRY PERIOD

The Photo Competition begins February 1, 2016 and ends on March 31, 2016. Entries submitted before or after the entry period will not be eligible. By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees to the official rules and regulations and warrants that his or her entry complies with all requirements set out in the rules and regulations.

WHAT TO ENTER

The UBC Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology works to integrate technology into teaching and learning, develop and deliver distance education courses and programs, and enrich the learning experience for students.

As UBC celebrates its centennial year, we want to see what teaching and learning in the 21st century looks like to you. Does it involve technology? Learning outside of the classroom? Collaborating with others on a more global or multidisciplinary level? Reflect on your experiences and capture a moment that expresses how you see teaching and learning in today's world.

Photos should be as high resolution as possible. Higher resolution files may be requested for winning entries. Photos must be submitted electronically in a .jpg format.

HOW TO ENTER

All images and information must be submitted though our contest website. There is no limit to the number of photos you may submit.

Entries must be original works. By entering the Photo Competition, entrants acknowledge and warrant that the submitted photograph is an original work created by the entrant and that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.

RELEASES

If any persons appear in the photograph, the photographer is responsible for obtaining the necessary releases, and must be able to provide copies of those releases to CTLT upon request. Please visit ctlt.ubc.ca/contest for a photo release form.

JUDGING

Photos will be judged on originality, technical excellence, overall impact, and subject matter relevance to teaching and learning in the 21st century.

A UBC committee will judge and evaluate all valid entries and pick the top photos. If your submission is selected as one of the top photos, you will be notified by April 2016.

The top entries will then go on to a public vote, via the CTLT Facebook page.

The winner will be contacted via the contact information provided at the time of entry.

PRIZES

CTLT will award the following prizes:

The First Place Winner will receive: One (1) Apple Watch

The Second Place Winner will receive: One (1) virtual keyboard

The Third Place Winner will receive: One (1) smart pen

RIGHTS
